The survey!

- ◆ I decided to survey all the students who graduated from the program since 1986. Did they find good jobs? Were they satisfied with the training they received at Stevens? Are they successful in their field? With the help of a few tool giveaways, to encourage returns, we reached an amazing 82% return rate!



The survey!

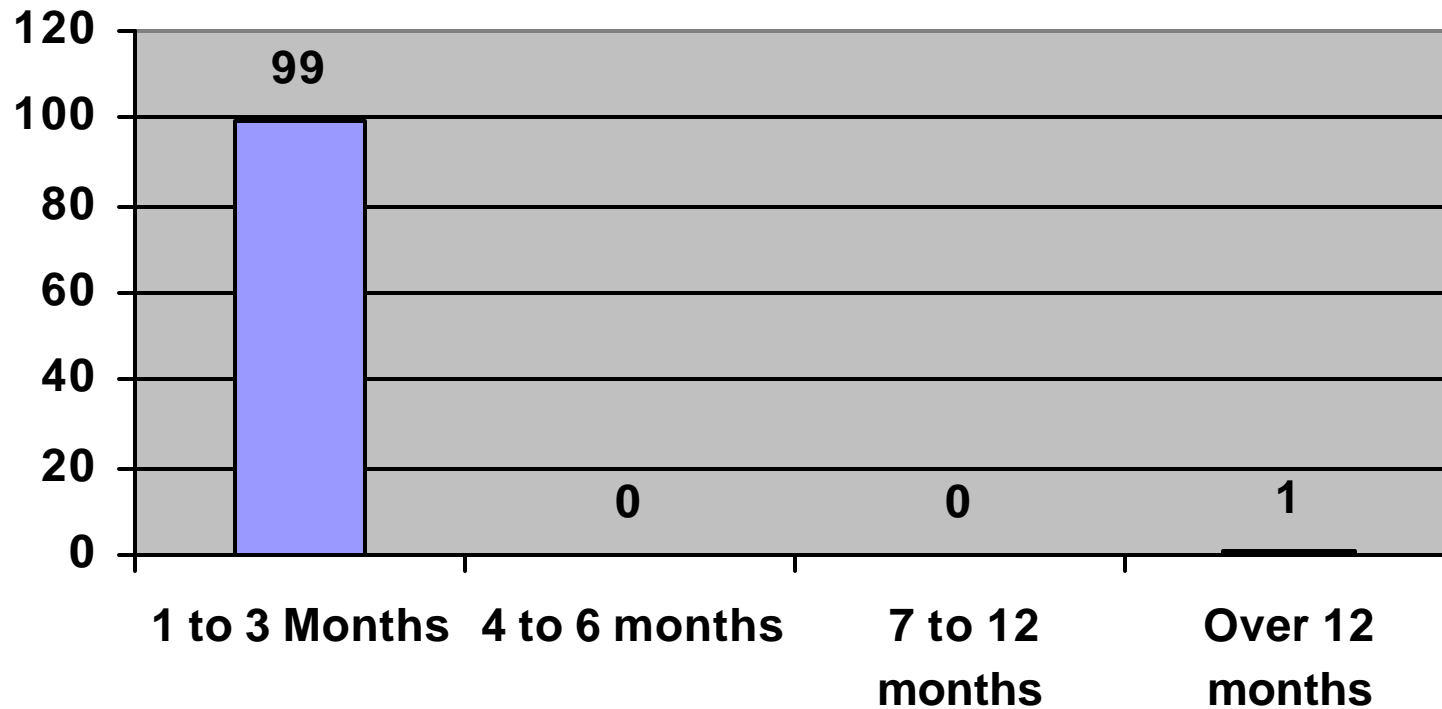
- ◆ Of the 82% who responded everyone was very open and candid with salaries, and everyone had positive comments about their experience at Stevens. Survey after survey contained testimonials of success in the automotive field, which they attributed to their technical training they received from the automotive program!



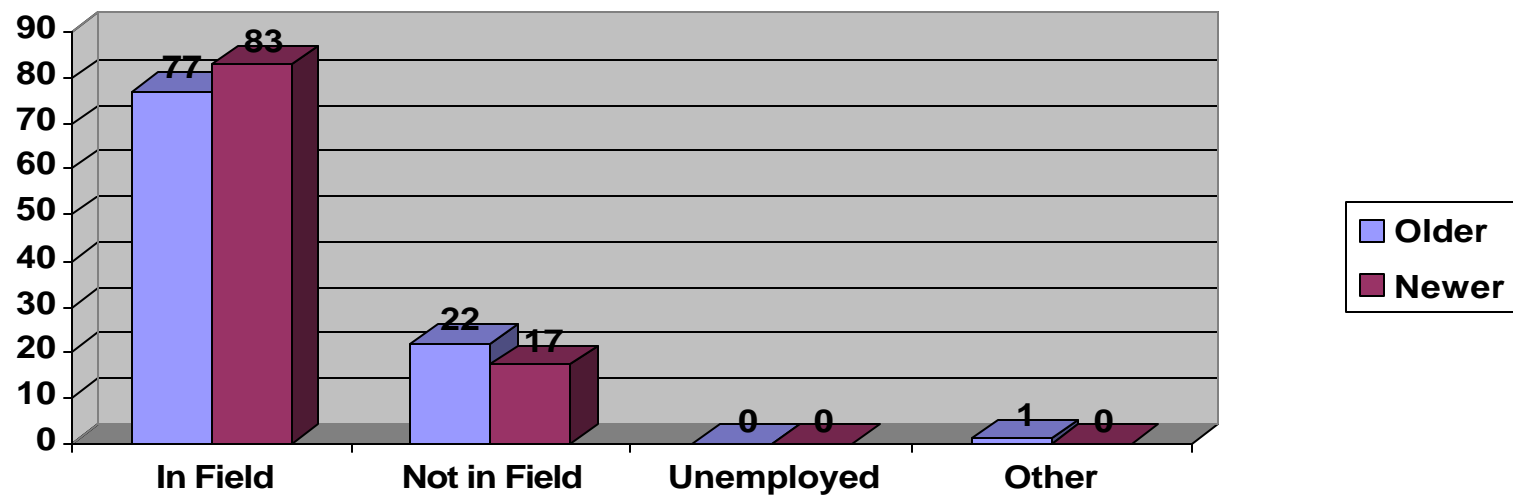
The survey:

- ◆ The first question asked was “What was your main reason for choosing the automotive technology program at Stevens?” 96% of the responders answered “to gain the skills necessary to get a job in the automotive repair field.” The remaining 4% had other reasons, such as continuing their education.

The survey: The chart below shows that 99% of the graduates got a job in their field within 3 months!

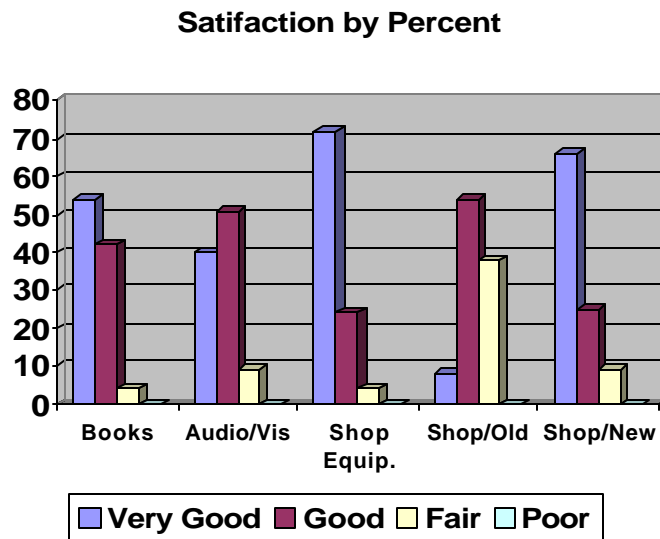


The survey: Are you still working in the automotive field.? The grads out 10 years or more are shown as older, and the results are shown by %.



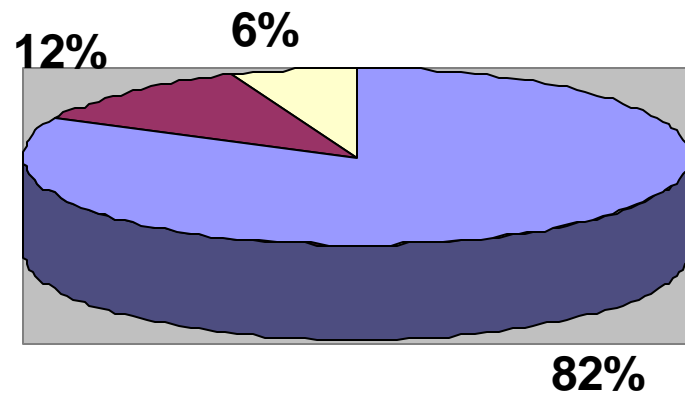
The survey:

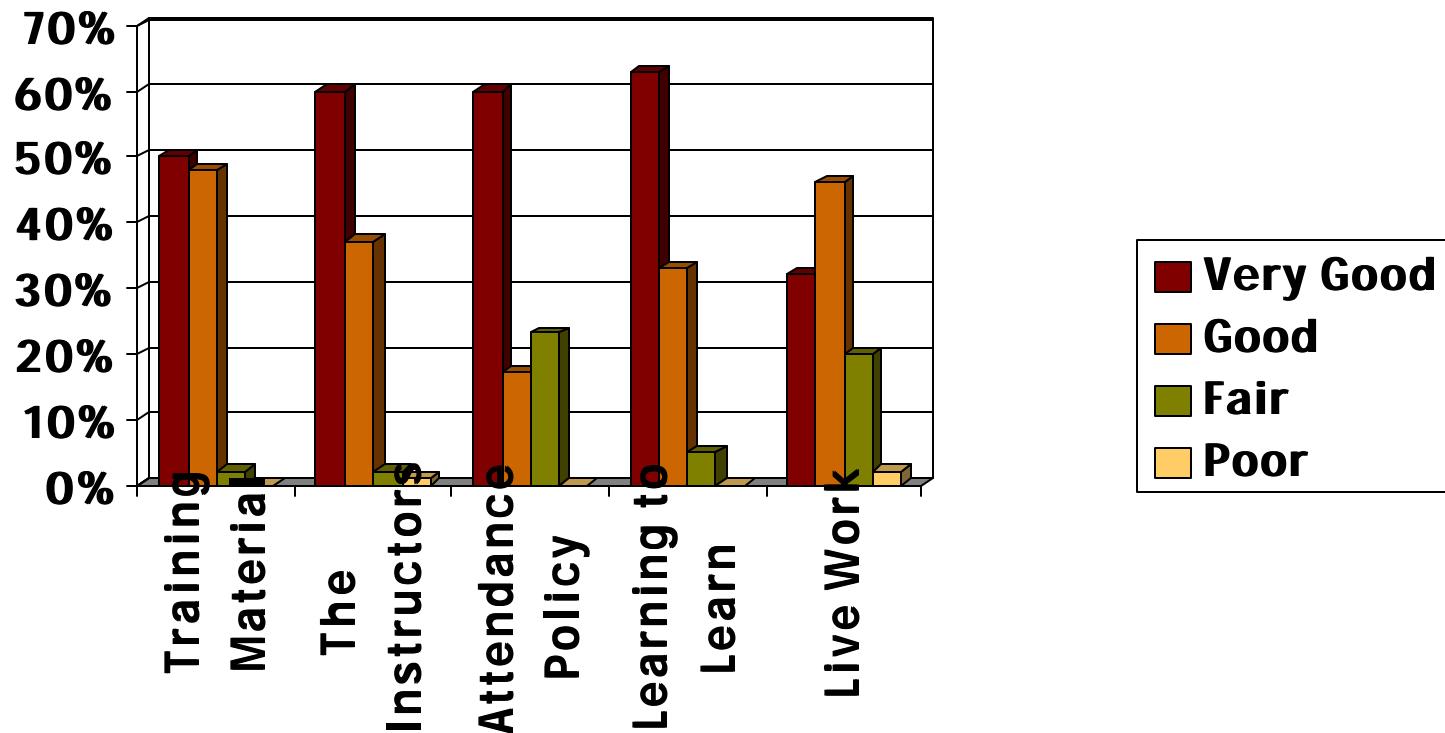


The survey: Question, “should we drop any of the courses, or stay comprehensive and keep them all?”

Would you change anything?

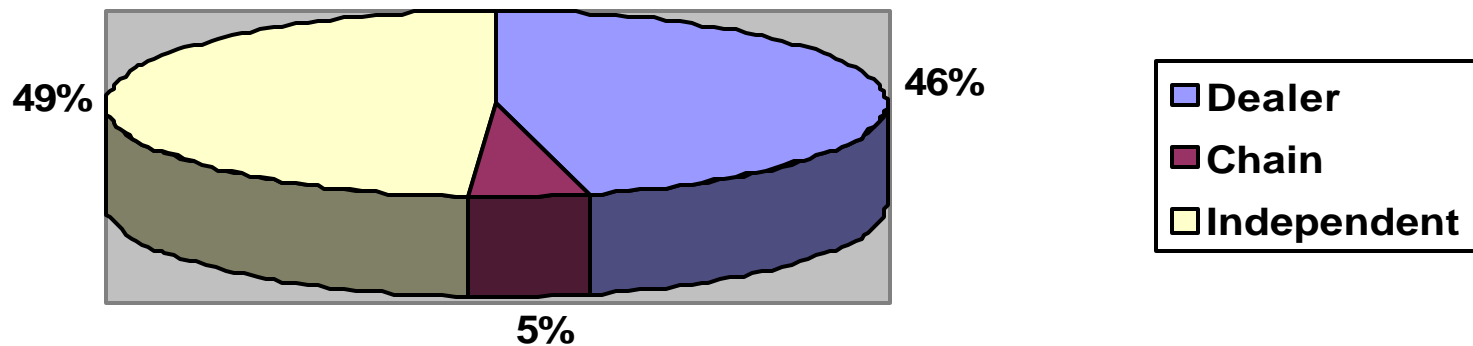


The survey: How did you feel about the things that were a major part of your training at Stevens?
